MARRIAGE PREPARATIONS FOR A MARRIAGE OR A MARRIAGE COVALIDATION

The Archdiocese of Miami requires a minimum of nine (9) month preparation prior to the wedding date.

As a parish, we are bound to follow the Archdiocese norms. Therefore, before you make any other arrangements such as booking your reception, your honeymoon cruise or flights for your family members coming from abroad, you need to meet with the priest or the deacon first, in the Parish office, to make sure that your date is confirmed on our calendar and that there are no other issues or impediments that could delay or jeopardize your wedding date. The Sacrament of Matrimony is a very important matter and needs careful preparation; some related documents may take time to process. Nine months preparation is a must.

Marriage Convalidation means to have a Civil Marriage be blessed in the Church. A copy of your Civil Marriage License showing the vital statistics is also part of the documentation that is required.
