

THE GOVERNING OFFICE

Catechism of the Catholic Church - Article 894—896

"The bishops, as vicars and legates of Christ, govern the particular Churches assigned to them by their counsels, exhortations, and example, but over and above that also by the authority and sacred power" which indeed they ought to exercise so as to edify, in the spirit of service which is that of their Master (LG 27; cf. Lk 22:26-27).

"The power which they exercise personally in the name of Christ, is proper, ordinary, and immediate, although its exercise is ultimately controlled by the supreme authority of the Church" (LG 27). But the bishops should not be thought of as vicars of the Pope. His ordinary and immediate authority over the whole Church does not annul, but on the contrary confirms and defends that of the bishops. Their authority must be exercised in communion with the whole Church under the guidance of the Pope.

The Good Shepherd ought to be the model and "form" of the bishop's pastoral office. Conscious of his own weaknesses, "the bishop . . . can have compassion for those who are ignorant and erring. He should not refuse to listen to his subjects whose welfare he promotes as of his very own children.... the faithful ... should be closely attached to the bishop as the Church is to Jesus Christ, and as Jesus Christ is to the Father" (LG 27 # 2):

Let all follow the bishop, as Jesus Christ follows his Father, and the college of presbyters as the apostles; respect the deacons as you do God's law. Let no one do anything concerning the Church in separation from the bishop (St. Ignatius of Antioch, Ad Smyrn. 8, 1: Apostolic Fathers, II/2, 309)."





LA MISIÓN DE GOBERNAR*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica - Artículo 894 - 896*

"Los obispos, como vicarios y legados de Cristo, gobiernan las Iglesias particulares que se les han confiado, no sólo con sus proyectos, con sus consejos y con ejemplos, sino también con su autoridad y potestad sagrada "(LG 27), que deben, no obstante, ejercer para edificar con espíritu de servicio que es el de su Maestro (cf. *Lc 22, 26-27*).

"Esta potestad, que desempeñan personalmente en nombre de Cristo, es propia, ordinaria e inmediata. Su ejercicio, sin embargo, está regulado en último término por la suprema autoridad de la Iglesia "(LG 27). Pero no se debe considerar a los obispos como vicarios del Romano Pontífice, cuya autoridad ordinaria e inmediata sobre toda la Iglesia no anula la de ellos, sino que, al contrario, la confirma y tutela. Esta autoridad debe ejercerse en comunión con toda la Iglesia bajo la guía del Romano Pontífice.

El Buen Pastor será el modelo y la "forma" de la misión pastoral del obispo. Consciente de sus propias debilidades, el obispo "puede disculpar a los ignorantes y extraviados. No debe negarse nunca a escuchar a sus súbditos, a a los que cuida como verdaderos hijos [...] Los fieles, por su parte, deben estar unidos a su obispo como la Iglesia a Cristo y como Jesucristo al Padre" (LG 27):

«Obedeced todos al obispo como Jesucristo a su Padre, y al presbiterio como a los Apóstoles; en cuanto a los diáconos, respetadlos como a la ley de Dios. Que nadie haga al margen del obispo nada en lo que atañe a la Iglesia (San Ignacio de Antioquía, *Epistula ad Smyrnaeos 8,1*).»



It is still your responsibility to be a safe adult, which means upholding healthy and appropriate behaviors when interacting with them. We take particular care when addressing environments and interactions involving minors because of their inherent vulnerability as children. Our behavior can make children less or more vulnerable, and less or more able to be manipulated (and possibly abused).

Prestamos atención especial cuando intervenimos en ambientes e interacciones que involucran a menores, debido a su vulnerabilidad intrínseca como niños. Nuestro comportamiento puede hacer que la vulnerabilidad de los niños sea menor o mayor, y que sean menos o más susceptibles de ser manipulados (y posiblemente maltratados).

SUMMER STUDY SERIES - FATHERS OF THE CHURCH

What did the Church believe and teach in the first decades and centuries after Christ? A large number of writings of the Fathers of the Church have survived. The earliest Fathers were disciples of the Apostles themselves, and the majority of the Fathers are bishops-successors to the Apostles—whose writings are a witness to the uninterrupted Tradition of the Church. We will see how the Fathers articulated the Christian understanding of the Trinity and the two natures of Christ, doctrines which were enshrined in the Nicene Creed and the first four ecumenical councils. In addition, they discuss many things which our Protestant friends reject—the structure of the Mass, the Real Presence, apostolic succession, the hierarchy of the Church, the role of Mary. When we read the Church Fathers we discover that the doctrines of the Catholic Church have been clearly taught by the Church since the beginning.






